Bash Editing Shortcu

Ctrl + k	delete from cursor to the end of the command line	
Ctrl + y	paste word or text that was cut using one of the deletion shortcuts	
Ctrl + xx	move between start of command line and current cursor position	
Alt + b	move backward one word	
Alt + f	move forward one word	
Alt + d	delete to end of word starting at cursor	
Alt + c	capitalize to end of word starting at cursor	
Alt + u	make uppercase from cursor to end of word

!blah	run the most recent command that starts with 'blah' (e.g. ‼s)	
!blah:p	print out the command that !blah would run	
!*	the previous command except for the last word	
!n	Execute nth command in history	
!\$	Last argument of last command	
İv.	First argument of last command	
^abc	Replace first occurance of abc with xyz in last command and execute it

Ctrl + g	escape from history searching mode	
Alt + .	use the last word of the previous command
